## CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Management Centres.....Drop your tree off, free of charge, throughout the month of January.

Middleton .....Town residents can drop off trees January 4-8, from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, at the site on the west side of Brooklyn Road. Call the Town office for details.

Berwick .....Residents can drop trees off at the Public Works site during regular operating hours or staff will pick them up from roadside during January.

Kentville .....The Kinsmen Club will collect trees in Kentville on Saturday January 9th as a fundraiser for charity. For details, call 902-678-6937.

Wolfville .....Christmas tree collection will run from January 4-15, 2021 and residents are welcome to set trees at the curb by Sunday, January 3, 2021 at the earliest. Trees can also be dropped off at the Maple Avenue Compost Site just outside the gate January 4-15, 2021.

Annapolis Royal .....Town residents can place trees at curbside for collection by the Town of Annapolis Royal.

**You can also cut the tree in 4ft. lengths, bundle it and set it out as brush for regular collection, or put it out for Spring Cleanup.**

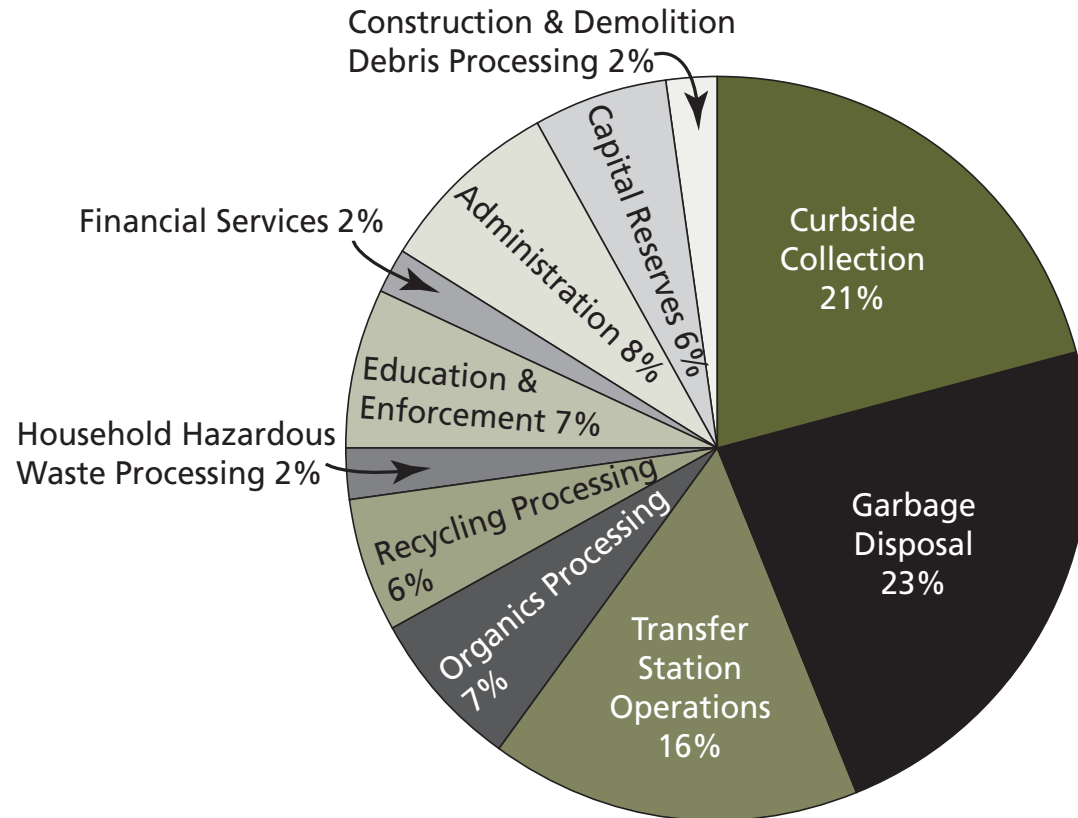
## TAX DOLLARS BREAKDOWN

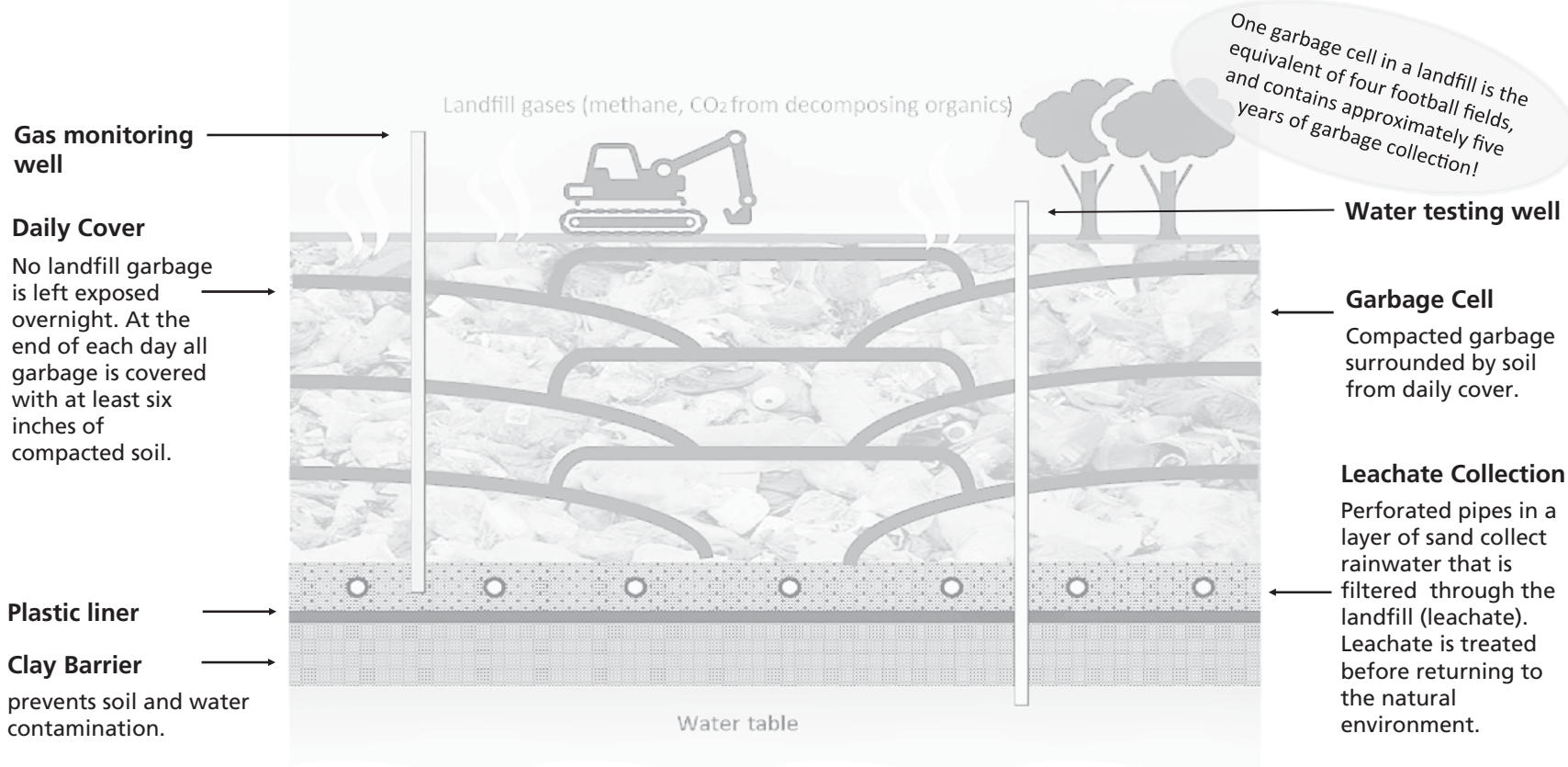

## Where does your garbage go?

The final destination for Valley Waste's garbage is Kaizer Meadow Landfill on Highway 14, and like all Nova Scotia landfills, it's engineered to prevent soil and water pollution that comes from our waste. Garbage is buried there and will remain in place for decades, centuries or millennia. Tossing organic material in the garbage (food waste, paper) causes garbage to break-down differently and turns it into a liquid called leachate, then methane and CO<sub>2</sub>. **By keeping organic material out of the landfill you are helping REDUCE air pollution and climate change!**

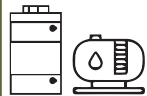
### Things that are NOT accepted



**Household appliances** like a washer, dryer and stove. **Please note:** Any cooling devices like fridges, freezers, airconditioners, dehumidifiers must have a CFC sticker. Limit is two appliances at one stop.



**Furniture items** like a sofa, mattress, shelving. Any one furniture or appliance item can weigh up to 91kg (200lb): other items must weigh no more than 34kg (75lb) each. Carpet should be rolled in 4ft lengths.



**Miscellaneous** items such as a water tank, boiler, empty oil storage tank (which must all be drained).



**Construction Waste** lumber or loose items must be bagged or tied securely in bundles no longer than 1.2 metres (4ft). Nails should be bent over or removed.



**Small Auto Parts** (no fuel or fluids)



**Cooling Devices** like fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers without a CFC sticker.



**Electronics** like televisions, computers, monitors, stereos, printers, telephones, microwaves and stereos are free to bring into the management centre or participating EPRA locations as part of the electronics program.



**Automotive Tires** Up to four rimless tires a day can be returned to any tire dealership, free of charge.

**Cardboard boxes** can be flattened and bundled in 3ftx2ftx1ft and up to two bundles can be put out with your regular collection.



**Garden Waste**

### RULES FOR CLEAN-UP

Your clean-up is **one day only**. Put items out no earlier than the weekend before your clean-up and no later than 7am on the Monday of your clean-up week.

**No** recyclables, cardboard or yard waste. Please remove batteries from items. Batteries can be brought in to the management centres or other participating locations for free.

Bagged items **must** be in clear bags.

**Maximum of 20 items** will be collected at any one stop. An item means a single object, bag or container or securely tied bundle. A bundle can measure up to 4ft in length.

Items not collected are the responsibility of the resident and must be removed from roadside when Clean-up is finished.

### WHEN IS YOUR CLEAN-UP WEEK?

Check the back cover for your designated Clean-up Week. Your allocated Clean-up Week is based on your regular collection day.

(For example, if your regular collection day is Friday, Week 1, your Clean-up week will be the 3rd – 7th May, 2021.

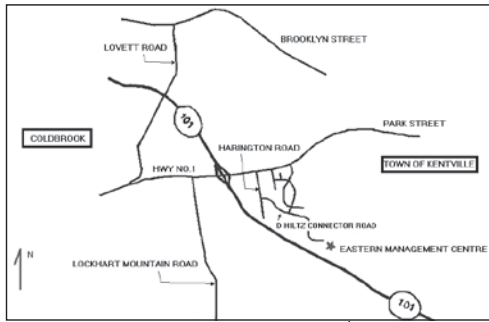

## REDUCE ODOUR IN YOUR GREEN CART

Each year, over 9,000 tonnes of organics are collected from Valley green carts and turned into a rich soil amendment called compost. Green carts, holding all this food waste, may get a bit smelly at times, but there are a few tricks to keeping the odour and pests at bay:

- Wrap food waste in newspaper or cereal/cracker boxes
- Keep the cart in the shade
- Put the cart out every collection
- Clean out the fridge the day before collection
- Refrigerate or freeze very smelly items until collection
- Hose out the cart periodically



*If maggots arrive, put the cart in bright light and leave the lid open. They will crawl down away from the light. Practice preventative measures after next collection.*



*Shopping bags are not meant for composting. Only food waste, yard waste and soiled papers go in the green cart*

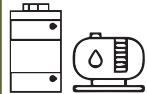
## Things that are NOT accepted



**Household appliances** like a washer, dryer and stove. **Please note:** Any cooling devices like fridges, freezers, airconditioners, dehumidifiers must have a CFC sticker. Limit is two appliances at one stop.



**Furniture items** like a sofa, mattress, shelving. Any one furniture or appliance item can weigh up to 91kg (200lb): other items must weigh no more than 34kg (75lb) each. Carpet should be rolled in 4ft lengths.



**Miscellaneous items** such as a water tank, boiler, empty oil storage tank (which must all be drained).



**Construction Waste** lumber or loose items must be bagged or tied securely in bundles no longer than 1.2 metres (4ft). Nails should be bent over or removed.



**Small Auto Parts** (no fuel or fluids)



**Cooling Devices** like fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers without a CFC sticker.



**Electronics** like televisions, computers, monitors, stereos, printers, telephones, microwaves and stereos are free to bring into the management centre or participating EPRA locations as part of the electronics program.



**Automotive Tires** Up to four rimless tires a day can be returned to any tire dealership, free of charge.



**Large Auto Parts**



**Cardboard boxes** can be flattened and bundled in 3ftx2ftx1ft and up to two bundles can be put out with your regular collection.



**Garden Waste**



**Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)** - Please see the page above **November** for more details of what is accepted

### RULES FOR CLEAN-UP

Your clean-up is **one day only**. Put items out no earlier than the weekend before your clean-up and no later than 7am on the Monday of your clean-up week.

**No** recyclables, cardboard or yard waste. Please remove batteries from items. Batteries can be brought in to the management centres or other participating locations for free.

Bagged items **must** be in clear bags.

**Maximum of 20 items** will be collected at any one stop. An item means a single object, bag or container or securely tied bundle. A bundle can measure up to 4ft in length.

Items not collected are the responsibility of the resident and must be removed from roadside when Clean-up is finished.

### WHEN IS YOUR CLEAN-UP WEEK?

Check the back cover for your designated Clean-up Week. Your allocated Clean-up Week is based on your regular collection day.

(For example, if your regular collection day is Friday, Week 1, your Clean-up week will be the 3rd – 8th October, 2021).

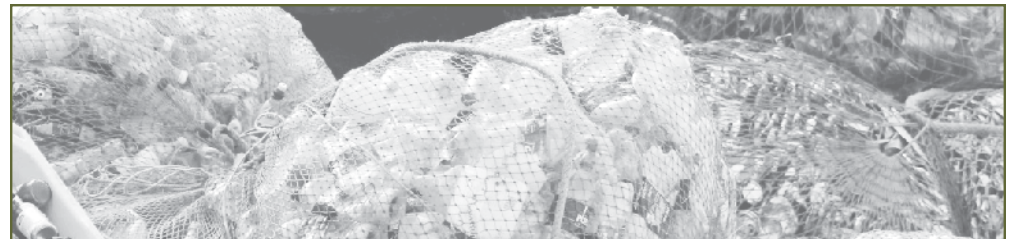

# Your Collection Service

All items must be at roadside before 7:00 am on collection day.

Collection day is once every two weeks. Place all materials in front of your own home, on your own side of the road.

## GARBAGE: 4 BAG LIMIT

**CLEAR BAGS MUST BE USED FOR GARBAGE.**

When necessary, one solid coloured bag per collection may be used for personal garbage items (eg. regular black garbage bag).

\*If you don't use your full garbage limits you can substitute each unused garbage bag with an additional recycling bag.

## Garbage

- Use standard size **CLEAR** bags. (Not longer than 39 inches when flat).
- Maximum weight per bag is 15 kg
- Large or bulky items are collected during Spring cleanup. See April for details.



## Recyclables

- Use standard size blue bags. (Not longer than 39 inches when flat).
- Maximum weight per bag is 15 kg
- Recyclables must be **CLEAN & DRY**
- Paper and recyclable containers (plastic, cans, milk cartons) belong in separate recycling bags.



## Cardboard

If cardboard can't fit inside your recycling bag, flatten and bundle to 3ft x 2ft x 1ft

- Up to two bundles of cardboard.



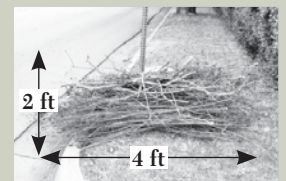
## One Green Cart

- Cart and contents must not exceed 100 kg (220 lbs).
- Do not overfill your cart – the lid must be able to close.
- If you require a green cart or mini bin contact the Valley Waste office. Fees may apply.
- **PLEASE** no plastic, metal or glass in the cart!



## Yard Waste

- Up to two bundles of brush; maximum length of 4 ft and maximum width of 2 ft.
- Leaves go in the green cart or bring to Valley Waste for free (bags must be emptied on site).
- Pine needles go in green cart or call Valley Waste for alternatives.

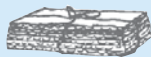
