5.1 Follow-up: Municipality of Kings Request for Payment of Invoice: Temporary Resources

General Manager Wort read an e-mail he received from CAO Scott Conrod. The letter requested a return of funds for the consulting fees paid for the cost sharing of 2 positions during a time in 2018 when a full time GM had yet to be hired at Valley Waste. All parties were billed and have paid with the exception of Annapolis County. Kings County would like those fees returned as the funding that was thought would cover these costs was not approved.

Mr. Corbin reminded the group that at the time there was no mention on this cost sharing being contingent on funding, and returning funds to each of the parties that have paid would create what he considered unnecessary bookkeeping. Wendy Elliott indicated that the minutes of this meeting should be examined to see whether or not there was a specific motion regarding this. Chair Kinsella noted that a letter should be sent to CAO Conrod thanking him for his letter and referencing the motions and minutes applicable.

Agenda Item No. 6 – General Manager's Report

General Manager Wort addressed the Authority highlighting the following items:

- General Manager Wort noted that there were a few staffing concerns he would like to address. The Office Manager could be off work for some time and this will create a huge void in Administration. There are also a couple of site workers injured and on light duties which is putting a strain on operations. It has become much harder to move staff around and he would like to discuss this in further detail at the Special meeting rescheduled for May 1, 2019.
- General Manager Wort also wanted to bring forward issues surrounding the budget. He would like to get a sense of where we are and how we proceed with a surplus from the landfill and how to manage issues with cash flow at the May 1st meeting. CAO Mark Phillips reminded Mr. Wort that the rules of the IMSA need to be followed when dealing with any surplus. GM Wort stated that we are in the mode of reacting to situations instead of having a strategic plan in place. Decisions made need to make sense on an environmental level, as well as a social and economic one. General Manager Wort stressed the importance of developing a strategic plan in the next few months.
