Materials approved for disposal at a C&D Site	Non-Acceptable Materials for an Approved C&D Facility - Must be Recycled or Disposed of at an Approved Landfill or Transfer Station
Creosote timbers	Materials banned from disposal in order that they be reused or recycled
Pressure treated wood	Caulking tubes
Laminated wood	Paint cans (full or empty)
Plywood	Other adhesive containers
Built-up glued wood sections	White goods- washers, dryers, water heaters, stoves, furnaces, fridges etc.
Particle or chip board	Furniture
Painted wood	Mattresses
Sawdust / wood chips	Curtains and other textiles
Gypsum board	Air handling units and heat pumps
Plastic / vinyl building materials	Large electrical components- motor control centres, capacitors, transformers, switching gear
Insulation- fiberglass, Styrofoam™ and other	Waste dangerous goods
Shingles- asphalt and other	Fuel tanks
Build up roofing	Contaminated soils
Carpeting	Used sandblast or shot blast waste
Vinyl flooring and linoleum	Batteries
Ceiling tiles	Electronics
