BATTERIES

Some lithium batteries can be flammable. Aim to drop batteries to recycle within six months, ensuring they are bagged or taped. Please make sure that lithium batteries are bagged. Visit www.call2recycle.ca for more information on safely storing and disposing of your batteries. Help keep batteries out of our landfill!

TIRES

NovaScotians can return up to four rimless regulated used tires for recycling to any tire retailer in the Province, during their regular business hours – free of charge.

ELECTRONICS

Some electronics are accepted for free at ENVIRO-DEPOT™ and management centres. Cooling devices are not included. www.recyclemyelectronics.ca/ns/



PAINT

The paint recycling program accepts residential paint products including alkyd paint, latex paint and paint aerosols at our Management Centres, some paint retailers, and some local ENVIRO-DEPOT™ free of charge.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

A product is considered household hazardous waste (HHW) if it bears one of the symbols shown here, or if words such as danger, poisonous, caution, or warning appear on the label. Hazardous products cannot be disposed of in regular garbage, they require special disposal.

Q: How many bags can I put curbside?
