Some Things You Should Know

Items Banned from landfill that can not go in a dumpster

- Automobile Tires
- TVs, Computers, and other recyclable electronics
- Fridges, Freezers, and other cooling devices

Avoid a penalty fee

If the dumpster contains a mix of garbage and recyclables, the load could be subject to a penalty tipping fee!

Disposing of items in a dumpster

Dumpsters are for **one** type of waste at a time.

Recyclable materials cannot go in with garbage. Neither the driver nor Valley Waste staff have the time to safely separate a mixed dumpster. If your dumpster hauler tells you they can go together, contact us.

Hazardous Waste including:

- Pesticides, cleaners, batteries etc.
- Propane tanks
- Paint
- Fluorescent lights
- Oil, Glycol, and other automotive fluids

If the dumpster is for garbage, it can be combined with construction and demolition materials (C&D), but not with cardboard.

A separate dumpster can be used for recyclable materials, or they can go curbside within regular collection limits. Visit our website for more information on curbside collection.
