## **Some Things You Should Know**

- In Nova Scotia many different materials are banned from disposal in landfill (see below).
- Any person who generates waste is required to sort all waste and store it separately for pick-up to make sure the banned items do not end up in a landfill.
- If the dumpster is being used for a renovation project or household clean-out, it cannot contain the following banned materials:

Automobile Tires	These can be taken to tire retailers for free.
TVs, Computers, & other Recyclable Electronics	Take to any EPRA recycling depot for free: http://recyclemyelectronics.ca/ns/
Hazardous Waste is <u>free</u> to bring to Valley Waste and must be separated from other garbage or recycling.	<ul> <li>Pesticides, cleaners, batteries, etc</li> <li>Propane Tanks</li> <li>Paint</li> <li>Fluorescent lights</li> <li>Oil, Glycol, and other automotive fluids</li> </ul>

- The following items must be separated and packaged the same as you do at home.

  Recyclables should be placed in blue bags, organics placed in paper or certified compostable bags before going into the dumpster (see our sorting guide or visit our website for more information).
  - o Food Waste, Leaves, and/or Brush
  - o Cardboard, Newsprint and other Recyclable Paper
  - o Beverage Containers, Tin cans, Glass Jars and Plastic Containers
