

Storm Debris Disposal



- Excess construction, demolition and renovation debris (e.g. wood, drywall, carpet, etc.) can be taken brought into the Management Centres in Kentville or Lawrencetown.

- Food waste from fridges and freezers that have gone bad due to power outages must still be separated from the packaging before disposal.
- Leaves can be put in your compost bin or brought and debagged onsite for free. Two armload tied bundles of brush no longer than 4 feet can be set out for curbside collection. Anything over and above that can be brought to our Management Centres for a small fee (please refer to our tipping fee schedule at <https://www.vwrm.com/services/locations-tipping-fees/>)

- If you rent a dumpster, items must be separated into their relevant categories i.e. garbage, recycling, cardboard. Clear bags only - no solid bags.
