- Operate equipment safely and report any issues.
- Support weigh scale operations and record keeping.

Groundskeeping & Maintenance

- Mow, trim, and keep grounds tidy.
- Collect litter and maintain transfer stations.
- Support upkeep of buildings—painting and minor repairs.
- Perform general equipment maintenance, greasing/fueling.

Community & Summer Support

- Support communications and enforcement staff with special projects on-site.
- Contribute positively to the fun, upbeat atmosphere of summer operations.

Working Conditions
